

Become a Member of UNCLE's Board of Directors

Volunteering to serve on your credit union's Board of Directors can be an extremely rewarding experience. You may find that representing your fellow credit union members not only benefits them, but will provide you with valuable knowledge for years to come.

Credit Unions are a not-for-profit cooperative that helps its members to realize their financial goals and dreams. Members are considered to be "owners" of the credit union and as such elect other members to serve on the Board of Directors.

Board of Directors:

The Board of Directors is responsible for directing and overseeing the affairs of the Credit Union. Members are elected to fill one to three-year terms and they are expected to meet for approximately two hours per month in service to the credit union and approximately eight hours a year in credit union education. Each Board Member receives a \$5,000 conference/travel stipend.

Duties:

- Guiding the strategic direction of the credit union
- Makes plans, evaluates progress, and appoints committees
- Responsible for setting credit union policies, objectives and long term goals
- Make sure the credit union maintains sound financial conditions

UNCLE Credit Union members may seek election to open positions for the credit union's Board of Directors by submitting a Candidate Statement and the "Official Application for Volunteers" to the Nominating Committee.
